

2.20 SCHEDULE OF FEES, FINES & PENALTIES

In this Regulation, “loss of points” means that no points are awarded to the offending team for the relevant match; and, for knock-out games, the offending team loses the match. “Deduction of points” means removal of points not relating to any specific match. BOD 2/14

2.20.1 Team Entry Fees

- a) Late entry prior to draw finalisation – 10% of entry fee.
- b) Late entry after the draw publication – 10% of entry fee.
- c) Withdrawal fee (prior to draw finalisation) – 10% of team entry fee.
- d) Late withdrawal fee (after draw publication) – 100% of team fees
- e) Late withdrawal fee (between 7 – 14 days of gala day) – \$300.
- f) Late withdrawal fee (7 days prior to gala day) – \$500. BOD 2/14
- g) Withdrawal fee (on the day – gala day) \$500. BOD 2/14
- h) Late withdrawal fee from Cups/Shields (after draw publication) – \$200.

2.20.2 Forfeits

- a) Late forfeit fee (after 5.00pm Thursday) – \$50 & additional KDFRA costs.
- b) Late forfeit fee (without notifying opposition) SSF or on the day \$50.
- c) Late forfeit fee (without notifying opposition team and/or KDFRA) Competition
 - i) First offence – \$200 + additional costs.
 - ii) Second/subsequent offence – \$400 + additional costs.
- d) Subsequent offences may result in additional fines, deduction of points and/or suspension from the competition.

2.20.3 Match Cards/ID Checks

- a) Failure to complete match card by stipulated time: (refer 2.7 Item k)
 - i) First offence – \$50.
 - ii) Second/subsequent offence – \$100 plus loss of points.
- b) Failure to provide printed electronic match card before match:
 - i) First offence – \$25.
 - ii) Second/subsequent offence – \$50 + loss of points.
- c) Failure to lodge match card within 14 days of match (match card deemed lost):
 - i) First offence – \$100.
 - ii) Second/subsequent offence – \$100 + loss of points. BOD 2/14
- d) Incorrect information (names, shirt numbers, ID numbers) – \$10 per offence, maximum \$50 per match card.
- e) Missing ID number – \$10 per offence, maximum \$50.
- f) Player’s name missing – \$50.
- g) Failure to verify opposing player IDs – \$50.
- h) Failure to provide ID sheet when requested – \$100.

2.20.4 Players

- a) Ineligible players in a match – loss of points. BOD 2/14
- b) Players playing 2 years over their eligibility:
 - i) First offence – \$50.
 - ii) Second/subsequent offence – loss of points. BOD 2/14
- c) Playing under an alias name – refer to P & D Committee.
- d) Incorrect strip – team not wearing approved strip:
 - i) First offence – \$100 + letter of reprimand.
 - ii) Second offence – between \$300 and \$500 + cited by relevant committee
 - iii) Third/subsequent offence – between \$500 and \$800 + loss of points.

NSFA Regulations

2.20.5 Referees BOD 2/14

- a) In Men's Football:
 - i) Failure to provide names in accordance with regulation 2.3(e) when nominating squads or teams – rejection of the nomination.
 - ii) Failure to ensure that a KDFRA-qualified Referee or Club Official is available for a home game – \$50 + loss of points.
 - iii) Second failure to ensure that a KDFRA-qualified Referee or Club Official is available for a home game – \$100 + loss of points.
 - iv) Subsequent failure to ensure that a KDFRA-qualified Referee or Club Official is available for a home game – fines not exceeding \$1,000 per offence + loss of points + further penalties that may include deduction of further points or exclusion from the remainder of the competition.

In other competitions, failure BOD 2/14

- b) to supply officials when required:
 - i) First offence – \$50
 - ii) Second/subsequent offence – \$100

2.20.6 Results

Failure to notify match results by the stipulated time – \$50 fine and/or loss of points.

2.20.7 Trophies

Failure to return perpetual trophy by stipulated time – \$100 + replacement cost.

2.20.8 Grounds

- a) Failure to provide corner flags* – \$200.
- b) Failure to provide nets* – \$25.
- c) Failure to open emergency access – \$25.
- d) Failure to open dressing sheds (where available) – \$25.
- e) Recurring failure to dress grounds may result in heavier fines, loss of points and/or suspension from a competition.

* Note: Corner flags and nets must comply with the FIFA Laws of the Game.

2.21 ISSUING OF FINES AND PENALTIES

- a) Fines and penalties will be issued by the NSFA office within 21 days of the offence or receipt of the match card. BOD 2/14
- b) Clubs who wish to dispute a fine or penalty must apply in writing to the relevant committee within 7 days of receiving fine notice.
- c) Alleged uses of ineligible players will be referred by the NSFA office directly to the relevant committee for determination.
